

**DISTRICT OF KATEPWA**

**BYLAW NO. 1-07**

**A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER**

The Council of the District of Katepwa, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
  - a) "Council" means the Council of the District of Katepwa; and
  - b) "Municipality" means the District of Katepwa.
2. Council is hereby authorized appoint a Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality as named by resolution of Council.
3. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving 30 days written notice.
4. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
  - a) to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality
  - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
  - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate
5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on April 16, 2007
